

ENTRANCE TEST SYLLABUS – 2026-27

U.KG. (BALVATIKA – III)

The UKG entrance is **not a formal written exam**. It is a **friendly interaction** to see your child's readiness.

➤ Areas of Observation

1. Language Skills

- Recognising and speaking A–Z (capital & small letters)
- Identifying beginning sounds (A for Apple, B for Ball)
- Speaking 4–5 sentence self-introduction
- Reciting rhymes (English/Hindi/Bengali)

2. Numbers & Math Readiness

- Recognising numbers 1–20
- Counting objects (up to 20)
- Simple comparison (big–small, more–less, tall–short)
- Identifying shapes (circle, triangle, square, rectangle)

3. General Awareness

- Knowledge of common fruits, vegetables, animals, birds, vehicles, colors
- Knowing days of the week
- Basic manners & habits (please, sorry, thank you, good morning)

4. Motor & Creative Skills

- Holding pencil correctly and tracing letters/numbers
- Coloring neatly within shapes
- Copying patterns (lines, curves, zig-zag, circles)
- Drawing simple figures (house, tree, sun, etc.)

5. Social & Emotional Readiness

- Listening and responding to teacher's instructions
- Sharing and playing with peers
- Answering politely
- Sitting attentively for short activities

➤ No extra preparation needed.

- The session will be **play-based, oral, and activity-driven**.
