CLASS VII

Subjects & Syllabus

1. English

- **Reading Comprehension** – Unseen passage
- **Grammar** – Nouns, Pronouns, Adjectives, Verbs, Tenses, Prepositions, Conjunctions, Subject–Verb Agreement, Active & Passive Voice, Direct & Indirect Speech (basics)
- **Writing Skills** – Paragraph writing, Letter writing (informal/formal), Story writing, Notice
- **Literature** – Prose & Poetry (Class VI level comprehension-based questions)

2. Second Language (Bengali / Hindi)

(Students will appear for either Bengali or Hindi as opted in school records)

Bengali

- **পাঠ্যাংশ পাঠ ও অনুধাবন** (Unseen passage comprehension)
- **ব্যাকরণ** – সমাস, উপসর্গ-প্রত্যয়, কারক, বিভক্তি, বচন, লিঙ্গ, ক্রিয়া
- **রচনা** – অনুচ্ছেদ লেখা, পত্র লেখা, সংক্ষিপ্ত প্রবন্ধ, গল্প লেখা
- **সাহিত্য** – পাঠ্য স্তরের গদ্য ও পদ্য (Class VI standard comprehension)

Hindi

- **अपठित गद्यांश** (Unseen passage comprehension)
- **व्याकरण** – संज्ञा, सर्वनाम, विशेषण, काल, लिंग, वचन, उपसर्ग-प्रत्यय, मुहावरे
- **लेखन कार्य** – अनुच्छेद लेखन, पत्र लेखन, निबंध लेखन, संवाद लेखन
- **साहित्य** – पाठ्य स्तर की कविता एवं गद्यांश (Class VI standard comprehension)

3. Mathematics

(As per NCERT Class VI syllabus)

- Knowing Our Numbers
- Whole Numbers & Integers
- Fractions & Decimals
- Geometry (Basic Shapes, Angles, Perimeter & Area)
- Algebra (Simple Expressions)
- Ratio & Proportion
- Symmetry
- Mensuration (Perimeter & Area of Square, Rectangle, Triangle, Circle)
- Data Handling (Bar Graphs, Pictographs)

4. Science

(Physics, Chemistry, Biology – Class VI NCERT Level)

- **Physics:** Motion, Light, Electricity (basic concepts)
- **Chemistry:** Changes Around Us, Separation of Substances, Sorting Materials into Groups
- **Biology:** Food and Its Components, Plants: Structure & Function, Body Movements, Living Organisms & Their Surroundings

5. Social Science

(History, Civics, Geography – Class VI NCERT Level)

- **History:** Ancient Civilizations, Early Humans, First Cities & Kingdoms, Ashoka, Ancient Trade & Culture
- **Civics (Political Science):** Understanding Diversity, Government, Key Elements of a Democracy, Panchayati Raj
- **Geography:** The Earth, Latitudes & Longitudes, Motions of the Earth, Maps, Major Landforms, India: Climate, Vegetation & Wildlife
